

Jolly Pirates Pre-School June Rhymes and Songs

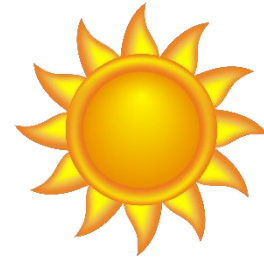
Songs and rhymes for young children can help speed up their development of communication, memory, language and reading skills, as well as being crucial for recognising and learning phonic sounds.

So we can play with you

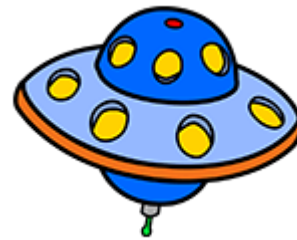
